A request for proposals to provide transportation services are available for pick up at the Jefferson County Department of Job and Family Services. The transportation will be provided for the contract period of January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025. Transportation will be provided to and from medical appointments through the Non-Emergency Transportation, Title XX, Adult Protective Services and SSI Case Management Programs. Local and long-distance transportation is required. Transportation vendors need to be available to provide transportation 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Appropriate insurance is required.
